

Dear Parents and Caregivers

From 3:00pm today, you will be able to book your children in for **orientation** and **Get Set for Prep Transition Sessions**. We ask at this time, that you book your child in for **one** orientation session and a maximum of **three** Get Set for Prep Transition Sessions. This is so that all families (including those yet to enrol) have an opportunity to attend. We will review the bookings regularly and let you know via email if there are any available spaces. If so, feel free to book your children in even if you have already booked your one orientation session and three Get Set for Prep Transition Sessions.

Below are the details of how to book.

- Orientation Sessions will take place in Week 4 – Monday 26th October until Friday 30th October. Please meet in the Hall for a 9:00am start. During orientation, your children will join a prep class and participate in their usual activities from 9:00am – 10:00am. You will remain in the Hall and there will be information about uniforms, YMCA outside hours school care and our book list. You will also have an opportunity to have a look around the school and meet some of our Admin team and P&C committee members.
- Get Set for Prep Transition Sessions will take place on selected Fridays and run from 8:45am – 9:30am. During these sessions, we will meet in the Hall where I will give you a brief summary of what we will be doing and where we will be. After this, children will come for activities while you remain in the Hall. These are a great way to meet new families and have a chat with other parents. Siblings are able to come along, but they will need to remain in the Hall with you.
